Becoming a League Certified Instructor (LCI) enables you to teach Smart Cycling which is a great way to help cyclists in your community. Certified instructors can teach the following courses and have the potential to earn extra income for doing so:

- Traffic Skills 101 (the basic introductory/intermediate course for adult cyclists)
- Traffic Skills 201 (an advanced adult course)
- Kids I (designed for parents of children under 10 years of age)
- Kids II (designed for children 10-14 [4th & 5th graders] including on-road practice).

Help bring the joy of safe cycling to others. If you are an experienced cyclist and would like to teach others please consider taking this course.

The LCI class is a one evening and two full days of both in-class and on-road course work. The registration fee is \$200. To take the LCI course, you must be a League member in good standing and have successfully completed the Traffic Skills 101 course.
